Please read schedule carefully to avoid exhibits being marked “NAS” - not as schedule. As this is a sugarcraft competition we ask that you keep the use of artificial aids to a minimum.

Wires must not be inserted into cakes. Plastic picks may be used.

Cleats may be a set of runners, under board or other suitable material used to raise a base board enabling ease of handling and to improve presentation. May be painted or covered with material or paper. They should not be obvious – cleats are included in judging when their requirements are clearly stated and written in the schedule.

Where the schedule calls for a cake, a “dummy” or block may be substituted. Dummies should only be allowed to mimic real cakes, i.e. they should never be used in ways that are unrealistic tiering or shapes. Cakes will not be cut.

All work must be the work of the competitor and completed within the last 12 months.

All care will be taken by the organisers with exhibits while they are being judged and on display, but all entries are entered at the exhibitors own risk and no responsibility can be accepted for damage or loss of exhibits.

Tier - A tier is defined as a layer or level of cake. They may be separated by pillars or stands or they may be stacked one on top of the other.
