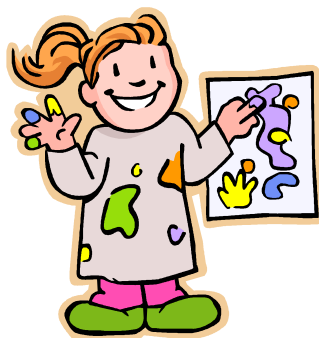

Raspberry & Almond Cake – Class 1102

| 175g unsalted butter, softened | 115g plain flour |
| 175g caster sugar | 1tsp baking powder |
| 4 large eggs | 200g fresh or frozen raspberries |
| 75ml sour cream | 25g flaked almonds |
| 125g ground almonds | 1tbsp caster sugar, for sprinkling |

1. Pre heat the oven to 180⁰ C/ fan 160⁰ C / Gas 4
2. Grease a 20cm round spring form or loose bottom cake tin and line the base with baking paper
3. Beat together the butter and sugar until light and creamy.
4. Add the eggs, one at a time, then beat in the sour cream. The mixture may look as if it is curdling, but don't panic.
5. Add the ground almonds, flour and baking powder. You should now have a smooth creamy batter.
6. Stir ¾ of the raspberries into the mixture and spoon into the prepared tin.
7. Scatter the remaining raspberries, the flaked almonds and the extra spoonful of caster sugar
8. Bake the cake for 1 hour to 1 hour 10 minutes, testing it with a skewer after an hour. If the skewer comes out clean, when inserted into the middle of the cake, it is ready.
9. The top of the cake should be wonderfully golden, crisp and cracking slightly.
10. Leave the cake in the tin for about 30 minutes before removing.

Cleats may be a set of runners, under board or other suitable material used to raise a base board enabling ease of handling and to improve presentation. May be painted or covered with material or paper. They should not be obvious – cleats are included in judging when their requirements are clearly stated and written in the schedule.

Where the schedule calls for a cake, a “dummy” or block may be substituted. Dummies should only be allowed to mimic real cakes, i.e. they should never be used in ways that are unrealistic tiering or shapes. Cakes will not be cut.

All work must be the work of the competitor and completed within the last 12 months.

Tier - A tier is defined as a layer or level of cake. They may be separated by pillars or stands or they may be stacked one on top of the other.

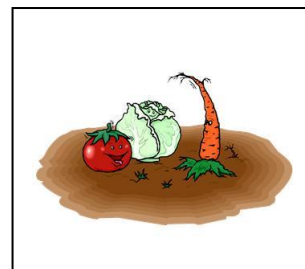

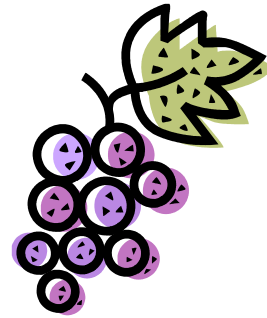
